

## Minutes of Henley Allotments' Association Committee Meeting 28<sup>th</sup> January 2019

- 1. Apologies for Absence: Lewis Every
- 2. Minutes of the last meeting: passed as correct

  - Strong balance of approximately £3500

- 6. Watermans:
  - No vacancies
  - HTC is now actively using the site for burning their waste; actively working with them towards creating a collective composting area
  - David Gobbett one of the longest standing plot holders is leaving in the summer
- 7. Greencroft:
  - A number of plot holders have been interviewed by the Henley Standard for a feature next month
  - Manure has been placed in the wrong area; Mandy to email Greencroft plot holders to encourage use of manure before we move it manually
