- Area of fence where deer were jumping over has been fixed by MT
- Complaint to Council over lack of maintenance

8. Watermans Renovation Plan:

- Phase 1 22 plot holders contacted; eight warning letters sent
 - 14 plots being monitored where work is underway
 - Three are being terminated in August
 - Five vacant plots
- Phase 2 Additional 15 poorly maintained plots to be tackled
- South edge has been strimmed by a volunteers as the Council have not done it
- Composting area under consideration
- Clean up day to be arranged late October/early November. SO to investigate skip options
